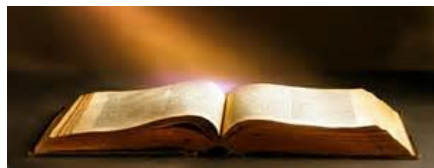
## Rosary Prayers:
